There is limited seating, reservations are required. Call or stop at the lodge.


Game Law Violations

The two individuals were then observed acting suspicious and the Pennsylvania Game Commission was notified. In a subsequent traffic stop the one individual was charged transporting an illegal deer (the 7point buck was not tagged). The second individual was not charged.
